CN RIDERS (newcomer riders who have never earned grading points at any level at any time in their life)

C1-3 RIDERS (riders with grading points)

- **All riders must have either an annual ESNZ Introductory membership \$40 (New - Replaces Community Membership) or ESNZ Children's Membership (New) or Full ESNZ Membership or pay a casual member fee of \$10 per day – paid via equestrian entries when you enter. - Combinations may enter two introductory/non-graded tests only. (Three if riding Prix Caprilli)
- Open to horses and ponies (H&P) – classes will be split if sufficient entries
- Combinations not to have won more than two Champions
- Horses/ponies may be unregistered, or ESNZ registered for non-graded or graded competitions AND not have more than 30 Level 2 or above grading points
- Combinations outside the above criteria may compete HC**
- We are running the 'Prix Caprilli Series', get points for placings in Prix Caprilli test at every tournament throughout the season except A&P and Champs.

ENTRY FEES: Graded - \$13 per class

Non Graded - \$12 per class

(Combinations restricted to two starts for the day, can do three if riding Prix Caprilli)

Ground levy/administration fee - \$12 per horse/pony

CONDITIONS:

- 1 All classes run under ESNZ rules.
- 2 Prize money – sweepstake for graded, non graded - ribbons.
- 3 Online entries **close Friday, 15th February 2019**. Enter online at www.equestrianentries.co.nz
- 4 Manual (paper) entries; These must be on ESNZ rider forms and sent to Kyla Newton, 55 Lytton Road, Riverdale, Gisborne, 4010 gisbornedressage@gmail.com
- 5 Entries will not be accepted without full payment of entry and other fees. Payment MUST be received by the closing date or you will not be included in the Draw. Entries without the correct/current ESNZ registration will not be accepted.
- 6 Please pay by internet banking - Gisborne Dressage, ASB Gisborne - 123170 0017212 00 or make cheque payable to Gisborne Dressage. Entries are not valid until full payment of all fees is received.
- 7 For classes 12 and 13, please state your test of choice (TOC).
- 8 The committee reserves the right to grade non graded combinations according to ability.
- 9 Late entries incur a \$10 penalty and will be put on a waiting list for a scratching (if any).
- 10 Scratchings – competitors will be eligible to receive a refund of their entry fee, less the ground/admin levy, with receipt of a vet/farrier/doctors certificate and SAE. This is to be received within seven days after the event. All scratching must be notified to Kyla Newton gisbornedressage@gmail.com
- 11 **Please note all helmets must have the approved red tag and comply with the new regulations being enforced from the 1 August 2017. Helmet tagging will be available at office. We will be checking riders before they enter the arena, no helmet tag, no entry to the arena.**
- 12 No dogs allowed (A&P rule)
- 13 Classes count for all local leaderboard challenges (Gisborne Dressage members only)
- 14 The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and to change the programme. Abuse of horses or officials will not be tolerated.
- 15 Spectators, competitors and equines enter the grounds at their own risk. The group accepts no responsibility for injury to spectators, competitors or equines while on the grounds.
- 16 Please read Health & Safety Management Plan on website under “What’s New” category.

**Article 482 - Competing "Hors Concours"

1. A horse may be permitted to take part in a competition "Hors Concours" at any level.
2. Permission must be obtained from the Organising Committee. The Organising Committee may withhold permission at their discretion without being obliged to give reasons.
3. Horses may not compete "Hors Concours" at National or other Named Events, or other events at the discretion of Dressage NZ.
4. The rider is subject to the rules as if he were a competitor in the competition in question, except as provide for in this rule.
5. Full entry fee must be paid but the competitor is not entitled to any prize or prize money or grading points.
